References to the book or your notes MUST include an attached photocopy highlighting the referenced section. Your challenge will be evaluated on BOTH the point you make AND how well you make it. [One or two phrases will NOT do.]

It is best to make a photocopy of your materials before you turn them in and keep the copy for your records.
